Essential Writing and Organizational Tasks:

- Create communication-related artifacts for solutions, services, and business processes. Examples include user manuals, procedural and policy documents, knowledgebase entries, and how-to articles.
- Interview subject matter experts to obtain information to create accurate documentation.
- Meet client specifications through consultation with stakeholders and technical teams within the university.
- Produce standard templates and guidelines for various written materials.

Additional Responsibilities

- A foundation in design, information architecture or usability is a plus.
- Produce artifacts related to user experience and information architecture.
- Prepare, administer and report findings of usability tests.
