The EIS Summer Intern program provides currently enrolled college students with the opportunity to sharpen leadership, technical, and business skills while gaining exposure to the technology and operations divisions of SunTrust. The overall goal of the program is for interns to develop skills through real work experience while adding value to SunTrust.

SunTrust is committed to the development of our interns. The Summer Intern Program kicks off with an orientation and social event to get the interns acquainted with SunTrust and each other. During the 10 week internship period, each intern will be assigned mentors, receive written performance feedback, complete an individual and a group project, interact with SunTrust executives, participate in interactive behind the scenes (Federal Reserve, Data Center, etc.) tours, participate in community service activities and attend Lean Six Sigma training.

- Production Services
- Technology Services

These divisions cover a wide range of opportunities and past interns have worked on projects involving business process improvements, internal tool enhancements, reporting efficiency, developing and documenting procedures, cloud-based solutions, application development, requirements gathering, project management, data analysis, infrastructure, and many more.

Successful interns may be considered for a full-time position upon college graduation, or a part-time position following the summer internship period.

- Must be available for continuous 10 week period for duration of internship
- Overall GPA of 3.0 or above required
- Solid leadership and interpersonal skills
- Proven analytical ability and attention to detail
- Proven ability to work well in a team environment
- Excellent written, oral, and presentation communication skills
- Solid interpersonal skills and client service orientation

Preferred requirements for technical candidates:

- Pursuing degree in computer science, systems engineering, management information systems, or information security
- Knowledge of relational databases, system architecture, software testing or programming
- Intermediate skills in Microsoft Access
- Current knowledge of and experience with Software Development Life Cycle methodology
- Application development experience preferably with Java/J2EE, or .Net
- Current, practical knowledge of Web site design, digital media, and/or Web 2.0 technologies and strategies.
