The Programmer Analyst, Intermediate supports integration of vendor-delivered solutions as well as designs and develop creative custom solutions of enterprise systems.

The Analyst Programmer, Intermediate will design and develop computer application systems by writing code, Java Script, web application architecture, network communication protocols and Java development.

Analyze computer application system and modifies programs when required by updating procedures and reports.

Maintain and enhance existing database applications and writing new programs

Verify accuracy and validity of programs using test data, written test plans and quality testing methodologies.

Evaluate off the shelf solutions and applications, prepare monthly reports from web logs, and provide technical support to affiliate states and partners.

The Analyst Programmer, Intermediate will assist in meeting the goals of the center by enabling users to effectively use supported enterprise applications. They will collaborate to ensure best use of delivered vendor solutions, develop custom applications, maintain interfaces between on-campus, in-house and hosted applications and assist in the analysis and implementation of new initiatives.
