Capstone is a two-semester program that integrates software engineering knowledge, formal software design principles, and tools/technologies for software system creation. Students form a team and choose a project topic through the guidance of a governing faculty.

WHY ENROLL?

- You have an opportunity to be a part of something unique and exciting! By enrolling in the pilot, you will be contributing to the course design.
- Workforce readiness - Capstone uses industry-standard practices and tools such as version control and project planning. This will provide valuable experience to better prepare you for the working world.
- Stand out from the crowd - This course attempts to simulate real-life work culture and aims to instill soft skills such as conflict resolution, decision making, negotiation, and adaptability.

PRE-REQUISITES

- CSC 4351 will be followed by CSC 4352 in the Spring 2023 semester. Please do not enroll in this course if you plan on graduating in Fall 2022.
- Students who have already passed CSC 4350 with a grade of C or better are ineligible.
- Must have passed at least one of the following courses with a grade of C or better - CSC 4520, CSC 4330, and CSC 4320.
- Must have passed the following courses with a grade of C or better - CSC 2720, CSC 3210, and CSC 3320.
- Students may not register for both CSC 4350 and CSC 4351 in Fall 2022.
